

Coronavirus: a book for children

Discussion Questions

- ✓ Talking to children about issues that worry them is not a one-off conversation. It is best to approach the topic by having a few 'bitesize' conversations. It gives your child time to think about what they are talking about, and time for reflection.
- We recommend using Coronavirus: a book for children in this way. Use it as a book that you keep returning to, rather than reading the whole book in one go.
- Here are some discussion questions you can use while you read the book.





After you have read the book, talk about:

What do you already know about COVID-19?

How does the book make you feel?

How can you help everyone stay safe?

What do you think might happen in the future?

Are you excited about going back to school? (Why?)

Do you know anyone who has COVID-19? How can we help them?

Don't forget that listening is important too. For children to be involved, it is important to show them that you value what they are saying. Remember to smile and show reassurance.

Encourage your child to ask you questions too. This is a good opportunity for you to share your values and what is important to your family.
