











Some considerations...



- 1. There is a group of teachers who are eager to learn
- 2. There are also teachers who would appreciate some relevant and solid CPD to help them navigate these new times.
- 3. Teachers may be spending hours creating lessons that may or may not be effective.
- 4. This may go on for some time

CPD as an opt 'in' activity in the MCO?

- 1. Consider a regular planned slot so teachers can plan their time
- 2. Ensure that the learning is relevant to their current situation
- 3. Be flexible and provide recordings for staff that cannot attend

Clear Instructions

- Repeat instructions 3x times
- Practice and Model
- Find a platform and stick with it
- Reflect on 'kinks' and adjust

Scaffold Questions

- Ask one question at a time
- It can sometimes be hard to hear

- 7. Repeat Instructions




