



More Than Half of Students Are Not Tuning In to Online Classes, Informal Teacher Survey Shows

As School Moves Online, Many Students Stay Logged Out

Teachers at some schools across the country report that fewer than half of their students are participating in online learning. APS: Youngest students have lowest participation rate in online learning

But the number of participating students in the youngest grades is much lower. Only 43.3% of Atlanta students in pre-kindergarten and kindergarten logged in at least once during that time span. The district held its last day of in-person instruction on March 13 and then moved to an online and distance learning model in an effort to stop the spread of the coronavirus.

"Right now, online classes' attendance rate is 80 per cent on good days, but it can fall to 50 per cent sometimes. Students cite many reasons, including waking up late, slow internet speed, and helping with house chores.







- Teachers have been sending reminders to parents' schoology accounts, when there is no response from the pupils.


