

LeapEd's Stories Submitted to Voluntary National Review 2021 United Nations Global Compact

Trust Schools Programme (TSP): LeapEd was formed in 2010 to work closely with Yayasan AMIR and the Ministry of Education (MoE), focusing on designing, developing and implementing the TSP.

A home-grown education service provider, we operated based on social enterpise principles, with a mission to raise the standard of education across Malaysia. The concept of each Trust School was to focus on improving student outcomes and school management capabilities.

For the pilot project, 10 schools from Johor and Sarawak were selected that provided a representative cross section of Malaysian schools – both primary and secondary, vernacular and multi-racial, urban and rural areas. By 2020, we supported 92 schools in 12 states and we are working to get as many more as possible.

TSP was created with sustainability in mind, and with continuous collaborations with stakeholders at different levels, gave us the boost to enhance TSP and also use key learnings to apply into different programmes.
